In the period from January 1, 2015 until July 31, 2017 a total number of 54 unaccompanied minors, who have been granted asylum, appear as the references in one or more cases of family reunification where permissions have been granted.

In the same period, the average processing time is 432 days in family reunification cases, where the reference is an unaccompanied minor, who has been granted asylum and where family reunification has been granted.

The figures for the years 2015 and 2016 are final based on administrative records from the electronic case and document handling system (ECDH). The figures for 2017 are provisional based on administrative records from the electronic case and document handling system (ECDH) as of August 30, 2017 and a subsequent manual review.

^{**}The figures may be higher as siblings of unaccompanied minors do not appear in the data if they apply for family reunification at the same time as their parents.
