Women in Policing (England and Wales)

At 31 March 2018, there were 36,417 female officers, representing 29.8% of all police officers (compared with 25.7% in 2010, and only 16.5% in 2000).

Female officers accounted for 34.4% of all officers joining the police in 2017/18 (compared to 30.5% in 2009/10), and 24.3% of officers leaving the police (15.7% in 2009/10).

The proportion of more senior ranks of Chief Inspector and above who were women was 25.4% (up from 14.3% in 2010).

There were 58 female officers at chief officer rank, representing 27.1% of total officers at chief officer rank (up from 15.2% in 2010, and only 7.7% in 2000).

Women accounted for 61.3% of the total number of police staff (61% in 2010); 45.3% of Police Community Support Officers (43.7% in 2010); and 29.4% of special constables (31.4% in 2010).
