Excellency,

In my capacity as Special Rapporteur for Follow-up to Concluding Observations of the Human Rights Committee, I have the honour to refer to the examination of the fourth periodic report of the Netherlands at the Committee's 96<sup>th</sup> session, held in July 2009. At the end of that session, the Committee's concluding observations were transmitted to your Permanent Mission. You may recall that, in paragraph 29 of the concluding observations, the Committee requested the State party to provide within one year further information on the specific areas of concern identified in paragraphs 7, 9 and 23 of the concluding observations.

At its 100<sup>th</sup> session, held in October 2010 in Geneva, the Committee noted information from the State party in which it alerted it to the fact that it would not be in a position to provide a follow-up response until after the deadline.

Therefore, I write to request that the above-mentioned additional information be submitted at Your Government's earliest convenience.
