Statistics of body and baggage x-ray security scanners used in correctional facilities in Thailand

As of 7 November 2024, the Department of Corrections has installed a total of 913 scanners namely walk-through metal detectors, x-ray baggage scanners and x-ray body scanners, in prisons across the country. These facilities include those housing both male and female inmates. The distribution of body scanner machines by category is shown in the table below.

For facilities that exclusively house female inmates, a total of 65 body scanners have been installed in 46 locations, compared to 25 locations in 2021.
