Committee against Torture**Decision adopted by the Committee under article 22 of the Convention, concerning communication No. 1093/2021*****

<i>Alleged victim:</i>	The complainants
<i>State party:</i>	Switzerland
<i>Date of communication:</i>	13 August 2021
<i>Substantive issues:</i>	Deportation to Iran; risk of torture

1. The communication, dated 13 August 2021, was submitted by M.M. and A.M., nationals of Iran. They allege that by deporting them to Iran, Switzerland would violate their rights under article 3, paragraph 1, of the Convention. They are represented by counsel.
2. On 23 September 2021, the communication was registered with a request for interim measures. The State party was requested to refrain from deporting the complainants to Iran, while their communication was pending before the Committee.
3. On 10 May 2022, the State party submitted its observations on the admissibility and merits of the communication, which were transmitted to the complainant on 4 December 2023.
4. On 13 May 2024 the complainant was reminded to submit his comments on the State party's observations. The complainant was informed that in the absence of response by 15 July 2024, the communication could be discontinued.
5. In view of the fact that no comments on the State party's observations were received, the Committee decided at its 82nd session on 10 April 2025 to discontinue communication 1093/2021.
