Convention, concerning communication No. 1128/2022<sup>\*,\*\*</sup>**

1. The communication dated 25 May 2022 was submitted by O.C., a national of Türkiye born in 1988. His application for asylum was denied in the State Party and he was facing deportation to Türkiye. He claimed that by extraditing him to Türkiye, the State Party would violate his rights under article 3 of the Convention. The complainant is represented by counsel.

2. On 23 May 2022, the communication was registered with the request for interim measures granted. The State Party was requested to refrain from removing the complainant to Türkiye, while the communication was pending before the Committee.

3. On 28 June 2022, the Committee was informed by the counsel that the complainant left the territory of the Republic of Serbia, and he was later detained in Germany. On 23 June 2025, the Committee requested information to the counsel regarding the situation of the complainant. On 24 June 2025, the Committee was informed by the council that contact with the complainant had been lost.

4. In view of the fact that there is no more information nor contact with the complainant, the Committee decided at its 83<sup>rd</sup> session on 14 November 2025, to discontinue consideration of communication 1128/2022.
