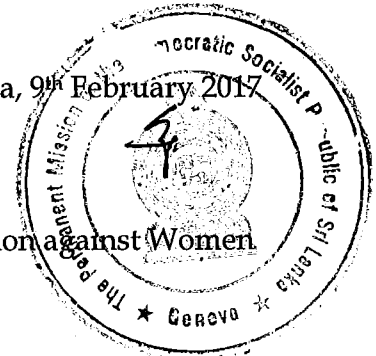
The Permanent Mission of Sri Lanka wishes to inform that further nomination to the above delegation is expected and will be informed shortly.
