**Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights****Decision adopted by the Committee under the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights concerning communications No. 230/2021 and 275/2022\*, \*\***

<i>Communications submitted by:</i>	V.M. et al. A.T.
<i>Alleged victims:</i>	The authors
<i>State Party:</i>	Italy
<i>Date of communications:</i>	3 October 2021 and 8 May 2022 (initial submissions)
<i>Subject matter:</i>	Eviction of family occupying a property without legal title
<i>Substantive issue:</i>	Right to adequate housing
<i>Article of the Covenant:</i>	11 (1)

1. The authors of the communications allege that the State Party has violated their rights under article 11 (1) of the Covenant by evicting them without alternative housing.
2. The Committee, acting through its Working Group on Communications, registered the communications No. 230/2021 and 275/2022, and requested the State Party to take interim measures to suspend the eviction of the authors pending the consideration of the communications or to provide them with adequate alternative housing, in genuine and effective consultation with them.
3. The State Party submitted its observations on the communications, which were transmitted to the authors for comments, who provided comments thereon. According to the information given, the authors have been provided with alternative housing.
4. At its meeting on 18 February 2026, the Committee, having considered the fact that the authors were awarded housing and that the cases had therefore become moot, decided to
