Excellency,

In my capacity as Special Rapporteur for Follow-up to Concluding Observations of the Human Rights Committee, I have the honour to refer to the follow-up to the examination of the initial report of Pakistan at the 120th session, held in July 2017.

At the end of that session, the Committee's concluding observations (CCPR/C/PAK/CO/1) were transmitted to your Permanent Mission. You may recall that, in paragraph 50 of the concluding observations, the Committee requested the State party to provide, within one year of the adoption of the concluding observations, information on the implementation of recommendations made in paragraphs 18 (death penalty), 20 (enforced disappearance and extrajudicial killings) and 34 (freedom of religion, conscience and belief).

A [letter of reminder](#) for the required information was sent to the State party on 8 November 2018. Nonetheless, the requested information remains outstanding.

In light thereof and in the spirit of openness and transparency, I should be grateful to meet with you or a representative of your Permanent Mission to discuss the matters set out above. Therefore, I invite you to a meeting on **Wednesday, 27 March 2019, at 2:15 p.m.** at Palais Wilson in Geneva (**room 4-083**).
