## Decision adopted by the Committee under article 22 of the Convention, concerning communication No. 987/2020\*,\*\*

Alleged victim: The complainant

State party: Ukraine

Date of communication: 27 May 2019 (initial submission)

Substantive issues: Torture and cruel, inhuman or degrading

treatment or punishment; measures to prevent acts of torture; prompt and impartial investigation;

forced confession

- 1. The communication, dated 27 May 2019, was submitted by O.H., national of Ukraine. He alleges that his detention and torture amounts to a violation of his rights by the State party under articles 2, 4, 13, 15 and 16 of the Convention. He is not represented by counsel.
- 2. On 7 February 2020, the communication was registered.
- 3. On 24 July 2020, the State party submitted its observations on the admissibility and merits of the communication, which were transmitted to the complainant 29 July 2020.
- 4. Reminders to submit his comments on the State party's observations were sent to the complainant on 16 March 2021, 9 December 2022, 7 March 2023, 3 July 2024 and 19 September 2024. The complainant was informed that in the absence of response by 21 October 2024, the communication could be discontinued.
- 5. In view of the fact that no comments on the State party's observations were received, the Committee decided at its 82<sup>nd</sup> session on 10 April 2025 to discontinue communication 987/2020.
