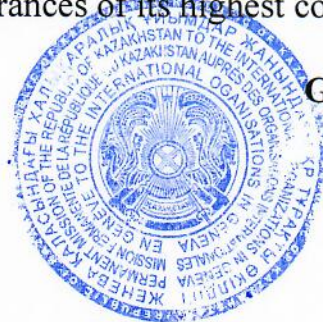
8. Ms. Dilnoza MINBAYEVA – Second Secretary of the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the UNOG;
