The Mission further informs that Honourable Solomon Van Westhuizen, Minister of Local Government and Rural Development will lead the delegation.

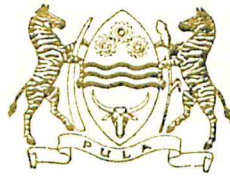

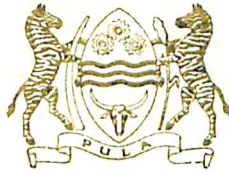

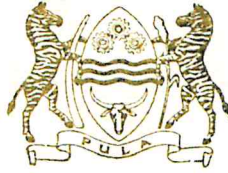
