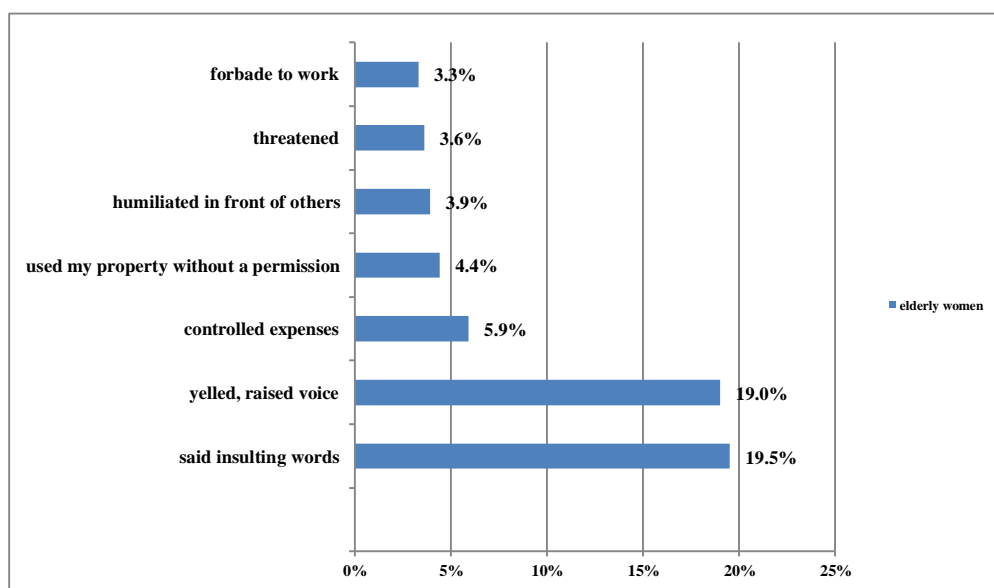


Responses of rural women who suffered action or intended action from their family members, including ex-husband or partners (findings of the Comprehensive Survey of Rural Women)

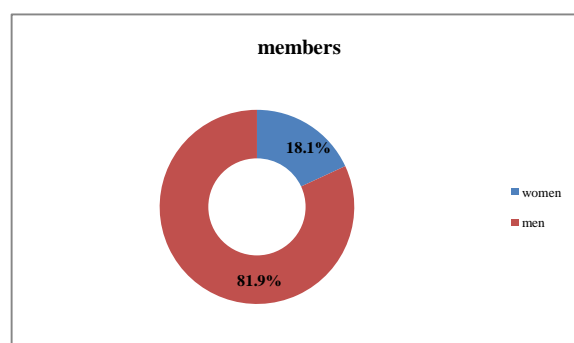
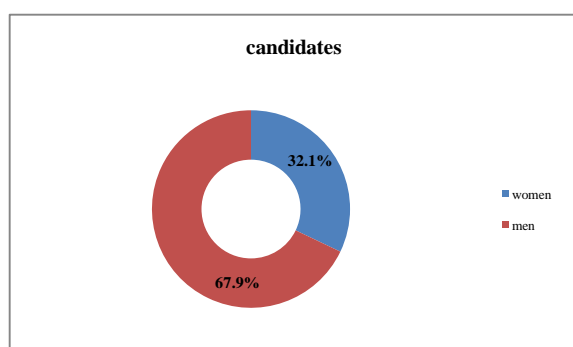
Share of the elderly women who suffered domestic violence, breakdown by the type of violence (findings of the survey “Elderly People in Ukraine”)



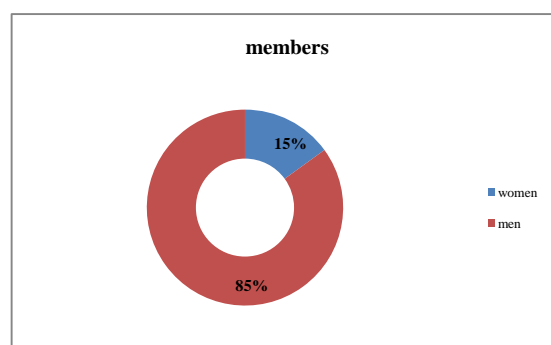
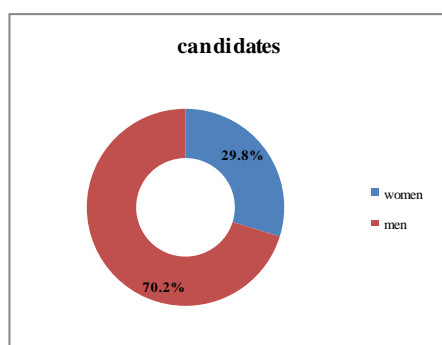

Women's representation in city councils after 2015 local elections (findings of gender monitoring by the Committee of Voters of Ukraine)



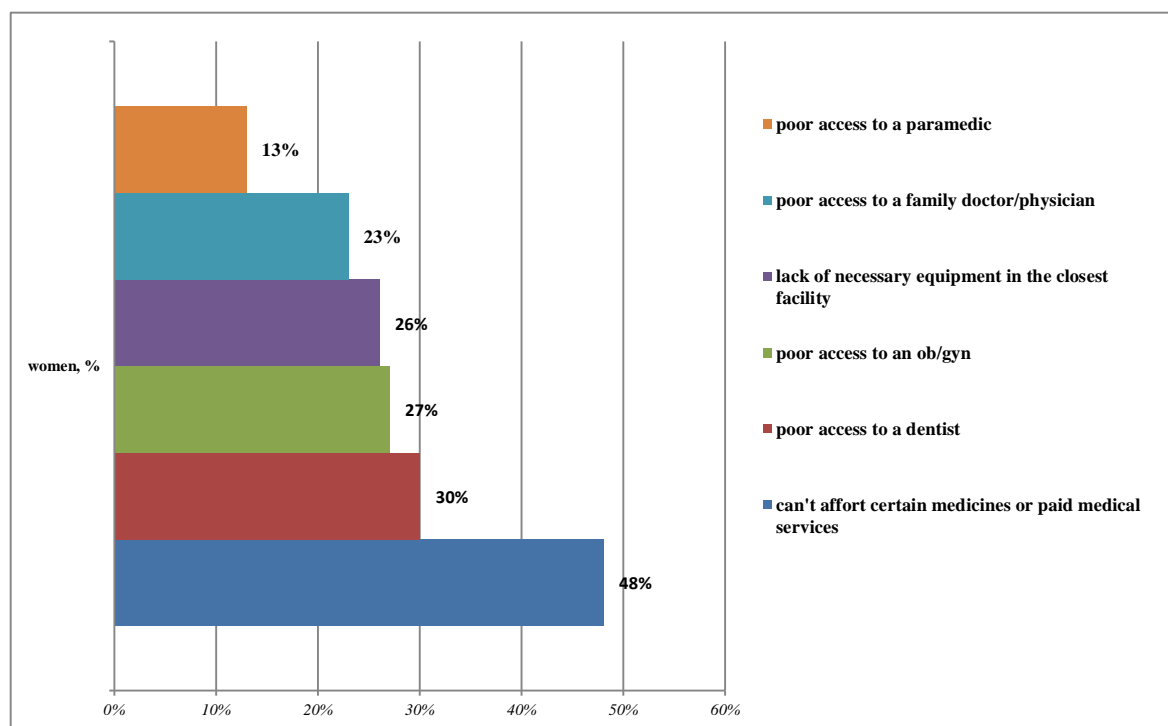
Women's representation in regional (oblast) councils after 2015 local elections (findings of gender monitoring by the Committee of Voters of Ukraine)
