Dear civil society and non-governmental organisations representatives,

The Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights will be hosting a private informal lunchtime briefing on Tuesday, 3 March 2019 from 13h30 – 15h00 in Palais Wilson, first floor conference room with representatives of civil society and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) who have a particular interest in its work.
